

Overview

The Jeju Forum for Peace and Prosperity is one of the major international forums in Asia where leaders from all around the world come together to exchange and discuss ideas on Asia’s peace and prosperity. It is held every year in Jeju, the Island of World Peace, with various agendas related to the region.

World leaders such as former Chancellor of Germany Gerhard Schröder, former President of Indonesia Susilo Bambang Yudhoyono, former Prime Minister of Japan Yasuo Fukuda, former Prime Minister of Australia John Howard, former Prime Minister of Canada Joe Clark, and President of Chinese People’s Association for Friendship with Foreign Countries Li Xiaolin served as keynote speakers at the Jeju Forum 2015. The Forum attracted 3,788 participants from 62 countries, including political and business leaders worldwide, renowned scholars, and prominent journalists.

The Jeju Forum 2016, under the theme of “Asia’s New Order and Cooperative Leadership” will be a continuation of the successes of the previous forums as well as a stepping stone to further accelerate cooperation and development in Asia.
